**Speaker:** [Lindsay Caron](#) graduated from Santa Clara University and the University of San Francisco in 2007 with Master of Arts in Interdisciplinary Education and Catholic School Leadership. She is the founder and executive director of the Theology of the Body Parent School (TOBPS), taught Catholic school for grades between k-12, and served as a Parish faith formation coordinator in both CA and OR. Her expert knowledge of Theology of the Body allows her to connect this subject to topics such as Catholic Social teaching, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd model, and safe environment training. Lindsay lives in Portland with her husband and 3 small boys.

**Topic:** Theology of the Body is often thought of as a couple's topic, but did you know you can deep dive into the Theology of YOUR body regardless of your relationship status? Young or aging, single or married, religious or lay, the theology of each individual body is a gift from God with a unique story written inside each soul.
