You have probably noticed in the entrance of the Church that the “Baby Corner Crib” has arrived. The Baby Corner helps families in the St. Pius and St. Juan Diego area, who are struggling to make ends meet. The Baby Corner provides basic necessities of clothing, diapers, hygiene supplies such as wipes and cream, and blankets. When possible, helping with larger items such as crib, (no drop sides), strollers, and pack-and-plays. There is a list of baby items placed next to the crib, please take one. There is a special need for preemie-18 month clothing and diapers in sizes 1-3. This is a way we can reach out and help women in difficult situations who are saying “yes” to new life.


