"Because water is typically accessible in the United States by turning on a faucet, we can easily take it for granted! Let's pause and think about all the ways we use water each day. ...Approximately 3 million people die each year because of inadequate water, sanitation and hygiene. 780 million people do not have access to clean water.... By 2025, 1.8 billion people will be living in countries or regions with absolute water scarcity. ... "

"Our Catholic Church has a body of teaching, called Catholic social teaching, which is based on our belief in the dignity of every human person. We believe that we are called to care for each other to make sure that each person is able to live in a way that honors his or her human dignity, which includes having access to basic needs like shelter, food and water (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 129)."

Aproximadamente 3 millones de personas mueren cada año debido a agua, saneamiento e higiene inadecuados. 780 millones de personas no tienen acceso a agua potable.... En 2025, 1.800 millones de personas vivirán en países o regiones con escasez absoluta de agua... "

"Nuestra Iglesia Católica tiene un cuerpo de enseñanza, llamado enseñanza social católica, que se basa en nuestra creencia en la dignidad de cada persona humana. Creemos que estamos llamados a cuidar unos de otros para asegurarnos de que cada persona pueda vivir de una manera que honre su dignidad humana, lo que incluye tener acceso a necesidades básicas como refugio, comida y agua (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n. 129)".

KITCHEN/COCINA

St. Juan Diego has a very active community supported by many wonderful ministries. As a result, our kitchen and hall are used constantly and by many groups. In an effort to have the kitchen always ready for the next group (which are often back to back), here are a few gentle reminders:

- wipe the kitchen counters down and leave clear.
- put away any items used in the appropriate labeled cupboards.
- dry and put away any items that were washed.
- take with you any food items leftover; don't leave on counters and in refrigerator.
- wipe down any tables used in hall and spot vacuum hall carpeting as needed.
- make sure items brought in have names labeled on bottom of dish/bowl (so can return easily).

- Secar y guardar los artículos que se hayan lavado.
- Llevarse los alimentos que hayan sobrado; No lo deje en la cocina ni en el refrigerador.
- Limpiar las mesas utilizadas en el salón y aspirar las alfombras del salón según sea necesario
- Asegúrese de que los artículos que traiga su grupo tengan nombres etiquetados en la parte inferior del plato o tazón (para que puedan devolverse fácilmente).
