Stewardship Moment

First Sunday of Lent. The second reading from Saint Paul to the Romans is a favorite of those involved in the ministry of evangelization. There are no "secret" disciples of the Lord. Those who exercise good stewardship of their faith realize that publicly identifying themselves as followers of Christ has a cleansing effect on their lives. Openly confessing Christ makes them more conscious of how they live their daily lives. Are we content to privatize our faith or are we good stewards of a faith that we share, make public, and regularly identify as a life in Christ?

Social Justice Lent 2022
Wednesday March 2 (Ash Wednesday)-April 16

Instead of giving something up for Lent this year, try walking a new step on the justice road every day. Each day of Lent we have a suggestion designed to encourage prayer, reflection, charity, and advocacy on social justice issues facing us today.

“Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?” Isaiah 58:6

- Day 5) Look a service worker in the eye – grocery store clerk, fast food worker, coffee shop employee –and tell them thanks, and that they are doing a quality job.
- Day 6) Advocate for hunger relief <https://www.oregonfoodbank.org/get-involved/advocate>
- Day 7) Take a walk and use all your senses to observe the gifts God has blessed us with; the birds that sing to us, the vegetation that surrounds us in color, the breeze upon your cheeks. Give praise and gratitude.
- Day 8) Turn off your social media today and spend that time in prayer for those who are confined, whether in prison, hospital, or their home.
- Day 9) Read the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops pastoral letter against racism.
