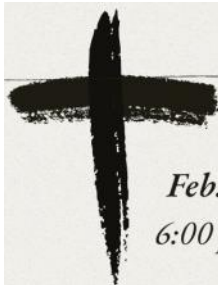

St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry

Our St. Vincent de Paul food pantry provides food backpacks every school weekend to 25 children at McKinley Elementary School. Weekend backpack programs help provide nutritious, non-perishable, and easy-to-prepare food for students who are at risk of food insecurity when they cannot depend on school cafeteria meals. The staff at McKinley lets us know how many backpacks they need and they maintain the list of the children receiving them. We are asking parishioners to donate items that are needed for this program. These items are: chili, mac & cheese, fruit cups (not applesauce), granola bars (kid friendly ones), and sandwich crackers (peanut butter or cheese). Please bring donations to the church for St. Vincent de Paul giving weekend (second weekend of the month) or drop donations off at the pantry during operating hours. You can also leave them in the narthex of the church by the St. Vincent de Paul donation sign. Thank you so much for your kindness.

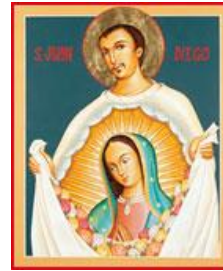
