Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Monday, September 19th. The Mass intention is for: **Respect for peoples of all races.**

What Is Racism?

Racism arises when—either consciously or unconsciously—a person holds that his or her own race or ethnicity is superior, and therefore judges persons of other races or ethnicities as inferior and unworthy of equal regard. When this conviction or attitude leads individuals or groups to exclude, ridicule, mistreat, or unjustly discriminate against persons on the basis of their race or ethnicity, it is sinful. Racist acts are sinful because they violate justice. They reveal a failure to acknowledge the human dignity of the persons offended, to recognize them as the neighbors Christ calls us to love (Mt 22:39). The document *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love - A Pastoral Letter Against Racism* was developed by the Committee on Cultural Diversity in the Church of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). It was approved by the full body of bishops as a formal statement of the same at its November 2018 General Meeting and has been authorized for publication by the undersigned.

¿Qué es el racismo?

El racismo surge cuando, consciente o inconscientemente, una persona sostiene que su propia raza o etnia es superior y, por lo tanto, juzga a las personas de otras razas o etnias como inferiores e indignas de igual consideración. Cuando esta convicción o actitud lleva a los individuos o grupos a excluir, ridiculizar, maltratar o discriminar injustamente a las personas por su raza u origen étnico, es pecaminoso. Los actos racistas son pecaminosos porque violan la justicia. Revelan una falla en reconocer la dignidad humana de las personas ofendidas, en reconocerlos como los vecinos que Cristo nos llama a amar (Mt 22:39). El documento *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love A Pastoral Letter Against Racism* fue desarrollado por el Comité de Diversidad Cultural en la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de la Iglesia de los Estados Unidos (USCCB). Fue aprobado por la totalidad de los obispos como una declaración formal de la misma en su Asamblea General de noviembre de 2018 y el abajo firmante ha autorizado su publicación.

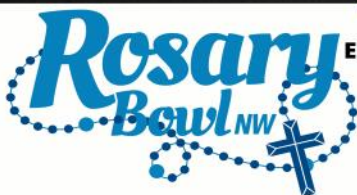
Preparation in English

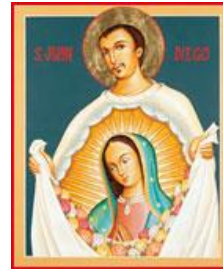
