In 1986, a compassionate woman named Karen Olsen in New Jersey became aware of homeless families in her local area and decided she needed to do something about it. She started the nonprofit organization now called Family Promise. In 2016 here in the Beaverton area many people came out to support the beginnings of our local Family Promise affiliate. Since that time over 500 of our local neighbors have been helped into more secure housing. With your help this year through Bottle-Drop, over \$5000 has been donated to Family Promise of Greater Washington County. This would be a great time for you to collect all those refundable bottles and cans in your house/ garage and bring them to St. Juan Diego to be recycled. The response on these two days is greatly appreciated but we need volunteers to carry the food items down to the pantry after each Mass. If you do donate non-perishable food items, the packages must be unopened. If you have an opened container with individually wrapped packages in it, that is fine.

Pantry most needed items: boxed cereal; 64 oz bottles of fruit juice (non refrigerated); a variety of individual fruit cups for the school backpack program. No canned beans, please.

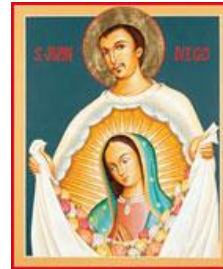

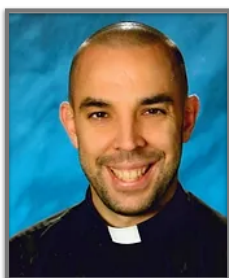
