Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Tuesday, March 22nd. The Mass intention is for: **Access to safe and clean water and sanitation.**

“Too many brothers and sisters, so very many brothers and sisters have access to too little and perhaps polluted water,” Pope Francis said. “It’s necessary to assure potable water and hygienic services to all.”...According to the United Nations data, three out of ten people in the world lack access to safe drinking services. In addition, more than 80 percent of wastewater resulting from human activities is discharged into rivers or the sea without any treatment, which causes its contamination, which leads them to estimate that by 2050, close to 60 percent of the world’s total population won’t have access to potable water.

Stewardship Moment

Third Sunday of Lent. In today’s Gospel Jesus offers his parable about last chances. The fig tree will have one last chance to bear fruit before it is cut down and destroyed. Good stewards realize that, like the fig tree, they are endowed with God-given gifts that are meant to “bear fruit” for God and neighbor. God has legitimate expectations of them. They also realize they do not know how much time they have left before the gardener returns for an accounting of their fruitfulness. How are we using our God-given gifts? How might we use our gifts to bear more fruit? The answer requires some urgency.
