A Stewardship Moment

In today's Gospel reading Jesus urges his listeners to "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." He also offers several examples of putting mercy into action. Listeners can then reason their way into how to put the values of the Gospel reflected in these imperatives into practice in other situations. Good stewards look for opportunities to exercise God's mercy toward others. They realize that, in doing so, their own experience of God's mercy not only becomes more profound, but affirms their hope of seeing the Lord face-to-face one day. How have we experienced God's mercy in our lives? How might our thinking, attitudes, words and actions reflect God's mercy on someone else today?

Welcome Our New Coordinator of Music, James Moursund

Corvallis native James Moursund was baptized Episcopalian and attended parochial elementary and middle school. Shortly after beginning at Corvallis High School, he resolved to pursue music—specifically choral conducting—as a career. Throughout high school, he studied conducting, voice, and keyboard, eventually earning degrees from Linn-Benton Community College, Oregon State University, and the University of Southern California. His graduate studies were interrupted in their final term by lockdown protocols, prompting him to search nationwide for work. In 2020, he moved to Florida to serve as music director for Saint Paul Catholic Church in Leesburg. In 2023, he decided to return to Oregon to discern the priesthood closer to his family. After serving as a seminarian at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Portland and Mount Angel Seminary, he has returned to "civilian life" as a church musician.

James considers himself blessed with a Christian upbringing and education. After a brief period of teenage agnosticism, he responded to the Lord's invitation—first reaffirming his belief in God, then in the Lord Jesus, and finally in the Church Jesus established. He was received into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil in 2017. A lifetime of experiencing God's mercy and the prompting of the Holy Spirit led James through a period of vocational discernment with the Archdiocese, and now to a continued commitment to serving the Church in Western Oregon as a layman.



Bienvenidos a nuestro nuevo coordinador de música, James Moursund

James Moursund, nativo de Corvallis, fue bautizado episcopal y asistió a la escuela primaria y secundaria parroquial. Poco después de comenzar en la escuela secundaria de Corvallis, decidió dedicarse a la música, específicamente a la dirección coral, como carrera. Durante la escuela secundaria, estudió dirección, voz y teclado, y finalmente obtuvo títulos de Linn-Benton Community College, Oregon State University y University of Southern California. Sus estudios de posgrado se interrumpieron en su último período por los protocolos de cierre, lo que lo impulsó a buscar trabajo en todo el país. En 2020, se mudó a Florida para servir como director musical de la Iglesia Católica de San Pablo en Leesburg. En 2023, decidió regresar a Oregon para discernir el sacerdocio más cerca de su familia. Después de servir como seminarista en la Iglesia Católica de San Patricio en Portland y en el Seminario Mount Angel, ha regresado a la "vida civil" como músico de iglesia.

James se considera bendecido con una educación y una formación cristianas. Después de un breve período de agnosticismo adolescente, respondió a la invitación del Señor, primero reafirmando su creencia en Dios, luego en el Señor Jesús y finalmente en la Iglesia que Jesús estableció. Fue recibido en la Iglesia Católica en la Vigilia Pascual de 2017. Una vida de experimentar la misericordia de Dios y el impulso del Espíritu Santo llevaron a James a través de un período de discernimiento vocacional con la Arquidiócesis, y ahora a un compromiso continuo de servir a la Iglesia en el oeste de Oregon como laico.
