Stewardship Moment

Fourth Sunday of Advent. In today's Gospel reading we hear proclaimed the story of the Annunciation, when the angel of the Lord announced to Mary that she would give birth to Christ through the intercession of the Holy Spirit. Mary allowed God's messenger to speak to her. She was attentive, not afraid to enter into a dialogue, then unconditionally obedient. Mary's acceptance of this mystery is a stewardship model for us. Good stewards remain open to the incursions of divine life into the normal course of their daily lives. How open are we to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in our own lives? What might we do this last week of Advent to be more attentive to the Lord?

The Nativity of the Lord (Christmas Day). In today's Christmas Mass at dawn we hear from the Gospel reading that God has entered quietly into the world. Not into the great city of Jerusalem, but into a small village about five miles south. Not into a noble family, but to an outcast couple keeping the newborn in a manger. Not announced by royal edicts, but to common shepherds, the first human heralds of Christ's birth. As Christian stewards we simply allow Christ to live in us no matter what our circumstances happen to be. We allow Christ to share his love with us and reflect that love out to others. We now are the heralds of Christ's Incarnation. What an unimaginable gift from a generous Lord. Good stewards rejoice in this gift and give glory to God.

Un Momento de Corresponsabilidad

Cuarto Domingo de Adviento. En la lectura del Evangelio de hoy nosotros escuchamos la proclamación de la historia de la Anunciación, cuando el ángel del Señor anunció a María que ella daría a luz a Cristo a través de la intercesión del Espíritu Santo. María permitió que el mensajero de dios le hablara. Ella le escuchó atenta, sin temor de entablar un diálogo con él, entonces obedeció incondicionalmente. La aceptación de María de este misterio es para nosotros un modelo de corresponsabilidad. Los buenos corresponsables permanecen abiertos a las incursiones de la vida divina en el curso normal de sus vidas diarias. ¿Qué tan abiertos estamos a la inspiración del Espíritu Santo en nuestras vidas? ¿Qué debemos hacer esta última semana de Adviento para estar más atentos al Señor?

La Natividad del Señor (Día de la Navidad). En la Misa de Navidad de hoy al amanecer escuchamos de la lectura del Evangelio, que Dios ha entrado al mundo silenciosamente. No en la gran ciudad de Jerusalén, sino en un pequeño pueblo casi cinco millas al sur. No en una noble familia, sino de una pareja marginada cuidando del recién nacido en un pesebre. No anunciado por edictos reales, sino por pastores comunes, los primeros heraldos humanos del nacimiento de Cristo. Como corresponsables cristianos nosotros simplemente permitimos a Cristo vivir en nosotros sin importar las circunstancias en las nos encontremos. Permitimos a Cristo compartir su amor con nosotros y reflejamos ese amor a otros. Nosotros somos ahora los heraldos de la Encarnación de Cristo. Qué inimaginable don de la generosidad del Señor. Los buenos corresponsables se regocijan en este don y dan gloria a Dios.

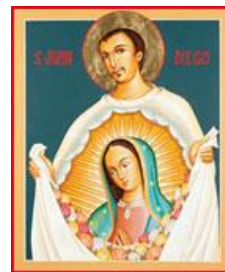
