

Stewardship Moment

Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. When Jesus is presented in the Temple, our Blessed Mother formally offers him to God's service without reservation. It is a service that Simeon prophetically foretells: a service to God that will turn the old laws and cultural norms upside down. Are we destined to hold on to old habits and customs tightly, or like Jesus, are we willing to serve the Lord and proclaim the Gospel in new and creative ways?

Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. We have become so accustomed to today's Gospel narrative of the birth of Jesus, this "Hallmark card" moment, that we may have the tendency to dismiss the sheer scandal of this scene. We have nobody but the despised shepherds coming to visit the couple who have nowhere to go. They find the child in the animals' feeding trough. Far from being welcomed into ordinary society or even royal company, he is rejected. Eventually, he will turn the social order upside down by his proclamation of the kingdom and his fellowship with the oppressed and marginalized. Good stewards know that, as disciples of our Lord, they must strive to look at the world through his eyes. This week imagine how you might view the world through the eyes of Christ Jesus.

Un Momento de Corresponsabilidad

La Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José. Cuando Jesús es presentado en el Templo, nuestra Madre Santísima lo ofrece formalmente al servicio de Dios sin reserva alguna. Es el servicio que Simeón predice proféticamente: el servicio a Dios que cambiará las antiguas leyes y las normas culturales al revés. ¿Estamos nosotros destinados a aferrarnos firmemente a viejos hábitos y costumbres, o como Jesús estamos dispuestos a servir al Señor y proclamar el Evangelio en maneras nuevas y creativas?

Solemnidad de María, Santa Madre de Dios. Nos hemos acostumbrado tanto a la narración evangélica de hoy sobre el nacimiento de Jesús, este momento de "la tarjeta de Hallmark", que es posible que tengamos la tendencia a descartar el puro escándalo de esta escena. No tenemos a nadie más que a los despreciados pastores que vienen a visitar a la pareja que no tiene a donde ir. Encuentran al niño en el comedero de los animales. Lejos de ser bienvenido en la sociedad ordinaria o incluso en la compañía real, es rechazado. Eventualmente, él pondrá el orden social al revés con su proclamación del reino y su comunión con los oprimidos y marginados. Los buenos corresponsables saben que, como discípulos de nuestro Señor, deben esforzarse por mirar el mundo a través de sus ojos. Esta semana imagine cómo podría mirar el mundo a través de los ojos de Cristo Jesús.




