Seventh Sunday of Easter. In today's second reading, we hear it proclaimed that we are blessed if we share in the sufferings of Christ. What then does it mean to "share in His sufferings" in this context? Most of us do not live in a part of the world where we could be killed for being a follower of Jesus. But we could face or "suffer" mockery, ridicule and disapproval from others. Far too often, and for various reasons, those who profess faith in Christ act as though they are ashamed of him. But to act ashamed is the same as a denial. Stewards of the Good News are never ashamed to reveal their love for the Lord. How do you reveal to others that you are a follower of Christ each day?

Creation Corner

Start Your Own Tomato Plants from Tomato Slices

1. Fill a container with potting soil almost to the top.
2. Slice the tomato into $\frac{1}{4}$ inch thick slices.
3. Lay the tomato slices cut side down in a circle around the pot. About 3 slices for a gallon pot.
4. Lightly cover them with more potting soil. They should sprout within 7 – 14 days.
5. Select the strongest ones and transplant them to another pot in groups of 4.
6. After the 4 have grown a bit, select the one or two strongest and allow them to grow.

Rincón de la Creación

Comience sus propias plantas de tomate a partir de rodajas de tomate

1. Llene un recipiente con tierra para macetas casi hasta el tope.
2. Cortar el tomate en rodajas de $\frac{1}{4}$ de pulgada de grosor.
3. Coloque las rodajas de tomate con el lado cortado hacia abajo en un círculo alrededor de la olla. Aproximadamente 3 rebanadas para una olla de un galón.
4. Cúbralos ligeramente con más tierra para macetas. Deberían brotar dentro de 7 a 14 días.
5. Selecciona las más fuertes y transplántalas a otra maceta en grupos de 4.
6. Después de que los 4 hayan crecido un poco, seleccione uno o dos más fuertes y déjelos crecer




