Climate Action Petition Social Justice Ministry

Brisk fall mornings, beautiful orange, red, and yellow leaves, pumpkins in a field; the beauty of creation is all around us this fall. We are God's stewards of this amazing beauty that we see here in our home and the beauty of all God's creation over all the earth. Care for God's Creation is one of the seven themes of Catholic Social Teaching. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us that we are called to protect people and our planet. The 26th United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP26) will begin in November in Glasgow, Scotland. It will bring nations together to accelerate actions toward the goals of the Paris Agreement and the UN Framework Convention on Climate Changes. The Catholic Climate Covenant, <https://catholicclimatecovenant.org/> has created a Catholic Climate Petition for individuals to sign to send to President Biden and the members of the U.S. Congress prior to the COP26 conference. The petition calls for action to:

- Drastically reduce greenhouse gas emissions so that global warming is limited to a 1.5 degrees Celsius increase, thus avoiding the worst impacts of climate change, and
- Consistently prioritize the needs of peoples most vulnerable to the impacts of climate change in the design and funding of national and international programs that generate climate resilience, ecosystem restoration and conservation, clean energy and water infrastructure, and just transitions for peoples impacted by the shift to a low-carbon future.

We must raise our voices together as a community of faith and let our elected officials know that it is imperative we act now to make changes to heal the earth and to care for the poor and vulnerable who are most impacted by climate change. The impact of our decisions and actions will affect the lives of our children, our children's children, and all God's Creation. Please take time to pray, discern, and give voice to the cry of the earth and humanity.
