He was a mystic and a pilgrim who lived in simplicity and in wonderful harmony with God, with others, with nature and with himself. He shows us just how inseparable the bond is between concern for nature, justice for the poor, commitment to society, and interior peace" (Laudato Si', 10).

These species help manage pests and increase pollination in your garden, so having a habitat for them can keep them around when you need them the most. 
