A Stewardship Moment

Today we hear one of the most beloved stories in the Gospel of Luke, Jesus’ parable of the Prodigal Son. Reconciliation is a prominent theme. Seeing the younger son returning to him, the son who left the family and squandered his inheritance, the compassionate father runs to embrace him. Jesus offers us a vision of a loving God who is merciful and forgiving when we, through our own sinfulness, leave his presence, and then through repentance, return to him. The remainder of the Lenten season offers us an opportunity to reflect on God’s compassion and our need for reconciliation. Consider celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation and experience God’s loving embrace and forgiveness.

El resto de la Cuaresma nos ofrece una oportunidad para reflexionar sobre la compasión de Dios y nuestra necesidad de reconciliación. Lent 2025 (March 5th April 20th)

Instead of giving something up for Lent this year, try walking a new step on the justice road every day. Each day of Lent we have a suggestion designed to encourage prayer, reflection, charity, and advocacy on social justice issues facing us today.

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?" Isaiah 58:6

Day 17) Fast from comparing yourself to others.

Day 18) Pick up the litter in your neighborhood today. Consider joining Adopt One Block and sign up to remove litter from your block on a regular basis. Adopt One Block will provide you with tools for your cleanup. <https://www.adoptoneblock.org/>

Day 19) Stop and think about everything that is imperfect—in you, in your loved ones, in the world. Pray the Serenity Prayer. (Google it!)

Day 21) Pray for judges, attorneys, politicians, and government leaders that they hear the voice of the Holy Spirit; so that justice is served, the troubled and hopeless are assisted, the war-ravaged countries are aided, and immigrant families are welcomed and healed.

Day 22) Eat at a restaurant, or find a recipe, that is culturally different from your normal cuisine. Try something new. Learn about the culture and the country.
