Stewardship Moment

Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord . Today we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, and in today's Gospel reading we hear it proclaimed that on Mount Tabor, Peter, James, and John caught a glimpse of Jesus' divinity strong enough to strike fear into their hearts. The event took place shortly after Peter's confession of faith that Jesus was, indeed, the Messiah. In today's second reading from Peter, we hear his personal testimony. This comes from a man who spent more than three years with Jesus. Peter witnessed his humanity. He saw Jesus hungry, tired, and finally, rejected and crucified. But he also saw Jesus feed the 5,000, walk on water, heal the sick, and raise the dead. He saw Jesus in his glory when he was transfigured. He saw Jesus risen from the dead and ascend into heaven with the promise that he is coming again in power and glory. How strong is the stewardship of our own faith? Do we accept Peter's apostolic witness to Jesus as Christ? Does this testimony help us acknowledge and trust Christ Jesus as our Lord and savior?

Momento de Corresponsabilidad

Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor. Hoy celebramos la Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor, y en la lectura del evangelio de hoy escuchamos la proclamación acerca de que, sobre el Monte Tabor, Pedro, Santiago y Juan vislumbraron la divinidad de Jesús lo suficientemente fuerte como para infundir temor en sus corazones. El hecho tuvo lugar poco después de la confesión de fe de Pedro, de que Jesús era el Mesías. En la segunda lectura de hoy, de Pedro, nosotros escuchamos su testimonio personal. Este viene de un hombre que pasó más de tres años con Jesús. Pedro fue testigo de su humanidad. Él vio a Jesús hambriento, cansado, y finalmente, rechazado y crucificado. Pero él vio también a Jesús alimentando a 5,000 personas, caminar sobre el agua, curar a los enfermos y resucitar a los muertos. Él vio a Jesús en su gloria cuando fue transfigurado. Vio a Jesús resucitado de la muerte y ascendido al cielo con la promesa de que vendrá otra vez en poder y gloria. ¿Qué tan fuerte es la corresponsabilidad de nuestra fe? ¿Aceptamos nosotros el testimonio apostólico de Pedro acerca de Jesús como Cristo? ¿Nos ayuda este testimonio a conocer y confiar en Cristo Jesús como nuestro Señor y salvador?

Pope Francis in Laudato Si' called all of us to "show special care for indigenous communities and their cultural traditions" (146) not merely out of defense for their rights but in recognition of how much indigenous peoples have to teach the world about the integrated ecology that the Church vigorously proclaims as part of the Gospel of Creation. For indigenous peoples, the Holy Father declared, "land is not a commodity but rather a gift from God and from their ancestors who rest there, a sacred space" by which they "maintain their identity and values" and that they "care for it best" (146). <http://secretariat.synod.va/content/sinodoamazonico/en/news/archbishop-bernardito-auza--the-mission-of-the-church-in-favor-o.html>

Proteger a los polinizadores

Algunos científicos estiman que uno de cada tres bocados de comida que comemos existe gracias a los animales polinizadores como abejas, mariposas, polillas, pájaros, murciélagos, escarabajos y otros insectos. Tú puedes ayudar a los polinizadores. Reduzca o elimine el uso de pesticidas en su jardín. Incorpore plantas que atraigan insectos benéficos para el control de plagas. Acepte algunos daños en las plantas destinadas a proporcionar un hábitat para las larvas de mariposas y polillas. Proporcione agua limpia para los polinizadores con un plato poco profundo, un tazón o un bebedero para pájaros con piedras medio sumergidas como perchas. Deje troncos de árboles muertos para las abejas y escarabajos que anidan en la madera.



Creation Corner

Protect Pollinators

Some scientists estimate that one out of every three bites of food we eat exists because of animal pollinators like bees, butterflies, moths, birds, bats, beetles, and other insects. You can help pollinators. Reduce or eliminate pesticide use in your landscape. Incorporate plants that attract beneficial insects for pest control. Accept some plant damage on plants meant to provide habitat for butterfly and moth larvae. Provide clean water for pollinators with a shallow dish, bowl, or birdbath with half-submerged stones for perches. Leave dead tree trunks for wood-nesting bees and beetles.




