Stewardship Moment

Would our response be the same as the rich man? Do we place our trust in our money and possessions instead of trusting in God's generosity? Do we seek security in our possessions? Good stewards realize that their possessions must not possess them, lest those possessions block their relationship with the Lord.

Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Monday, October 14. The Mass intention is for: **Those who suffer with mental illness and trauma.**

“Our nation faces a dire mental health crisis. According to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, more than one in five adults live with mental illness....We are particularly concerned about the mental health state of adolescents. Almost all indicators of poor mental health among high schoolers increased over the past decade....Even when mental health resources are available, they may not be affordable. In 2021, over a quarter of adults with a mental illness perceived an unmet need for mental health services, and the most common reason for not receiving services was the cost of care.... We, as Catholics, can and must respond to this challenge with the hope and compassion of our Lord. Individuals with mental illness and those facing mental health challenges are created in the image and likeness of God. They retain their God-given dignity.”

Según el Centro para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades, más de uno de cada cinco adultos vive con una enfermedad mental. ...Estamos particularmente preocupados por el estado de salud mental de los adolescentes. Casi todos los indicadores de mala salud mental entre los estudiantes de secundaria aumentaron durante la última década....Incluso cuando hay recursos de salud mental disponibles, es posible que no sean asequibles. En 2021, más de una cuarta parte de los adultos con una enfermedad mental percibieron una necesidad insatisfecha de servicios de salud mental, y la razón más común para no recibir servicios fue el costo de la atención.... Nosotros, como católicos, podemos y debemos responder a este desafío con la esperanza y la compasión de nuestro Señor. Las personas con enfermedades mentales y aquellas que enfrentan problemas de salud mental son creadas a imagen y semejanza de Dios.
