Stewardship Moments

Second Sunday of Easter. In today's first reading, the four activities of the earliest church are introduced to us as priorities of the church: devotion to the teachings of the apostles, communal fellowship, the Eucharist and prayer. The early members of the church saw themselves as devoted stewards of these activities. These were not options. They were the fruits of a genuine conversion to a life in Christ. Sharing in the Eucharist was the most intimate expression of fellowship, while the most common expression of fellowship in the New Testament was that of sharing financial resources – giving. It was not a perfect community, but one that gave evidence of God's active presence in its midst. This early community offers us an excellent example of how to better exercise stewardship in our own parish families.

Momentos de Corresponsabilidad

Segundo Domingo de Pascua. En la primera lectura de hoy, las cuatro actividades de la iglesia primitiva se nos presentan como prioridades de la iglesia: la devoción a las enseñanzas de los apóstoles, la comunión comunitaria, la Eucaristía y la oración. Los primeros miembros de la iglesia se veían a sí mismos como devotos corresponsables de estas actividades. Éstas no eran opcionales. Eran los frutos de una conversión genuina a una vida en Cristo. Compartir en la Eucaristía era la expresión más íntima de compañerismo, mientras la expresión más común de comunión en el Nuevo Testamento era la de compartir los recursos económicos – dar. No era una comunidad perfecta, sino una que daba evidencia de la presencia activa de Dios en el centro de ella. Esta primera comunidad nos ofrece un excelente ejemplo sobre cómo ejercitar mejor la corresponsabilidad en nuestras propias familias parroquiales.

St. Vincent de Paul Pantry Update

During March our pantry served 98 families, comprised of 395 people, providing 7,000 pounds of food. Parishioners really stepped up during the Knights of Columbus 40 Cans for Lent food drive. Between that and a Boy Scouts Food drive, we received almost 6,000 pounds of food. This has really helped to replenish the shelves in the food pantry. There are still some items that we are in need of to help round out our offerings. They are: canned peaches; tomato sauce; flavored noodles (such as Noodle Roni); chili; chicken noodle soup; and raisins. Please remember that this is St. Vincent de Paul giving weekend. The generosity and kindness of our parishioners is greatly appreciated.

Actualización de la despensa de St. Vincent de Paul

Durante el mes de marzo nuestra despensa atendió a 98 familias, compuestas por 395 personas, aportando 7,000 libras de alimentos. Los feligreses realmente dieron un paso al frente durante la colecta de alimentos 40 latas para la Cuaresma de los Caballeros de Colón. Entre eso y una colecta de alimentos de Boy Scouts, recibimos casi 6,000 libras de alimentos. Esto realmente ha ayudado a reponer los estantes en la despensa de alimentos. Todavía hay algunos artículos que necesitamos para ayudar a completar nuestras ofertas. Ellos son: duraznos enlatados; salsa de tomate; fideos con sabor (como Noodle Roni); chile; sopa de fideos con pollo; y pasas. Recuerde que este es el fin de semana de donaciones de San Vicente de Paúl. La generosidad y amabilidad de nuestros feligreses es muy apreciada.




